## NOTICE TO MARINERS No.5 OF 2020

### **Stormont Wharf North - Concrete Repairs Area Adjacent to Bollard 15**

Mariners are advised that essential concrete repair work will commence on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020 at Stormont Wharf North. The work area is adjacent to Bollard 15, as shown on the attached plan. Work is expected to be completed in 3 weeks.

During this work the contractor is responsible for the area and will cordon off the quay adjacent to the work area. Cranes, hoppers, plant, vehicles and pedestrians will not be permitted on the quay within the work area. Crane 89, Hopper 89 and Crane 96 will be positioned north of the work area.

Scaffolding will be erected over the side and underneath the quay adjacent to bollard 15 (approximately 5 metres either side), but will be kept inside the fender line. Access to the quay front will be restricted at bollard 15. All bollards, apart from bollard 15 will remain in use. It will not be possible to run mooring lines over the work area.

The majority of the work will take place at the front and underneath the quay.

**During the periods of work a slow pass and minimum wake will be required from all passing vessels / craft.**

**No work on the water or underneath the quay will take place when vessels are arriving, departing or shifting at Stormont North and Centre berths. Port Control will manage this interface and should be contacted prior to arriving, departing or shifting in this area.**
