### Dredging and hydrographic surveys in Belfast Harbour

Dredging and hydrographic surveys of the Victoria Channel from Seaward of Buoys No.1 and 2 in to the inner harbour, including the Herdman and Musgrave channels is scheduled to commence on the 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and last for approximately 6 weeks.

This work will be carried out by the following Vessels:

**AL IDRISI** - Trailing Suction Hopper Dredger LOA; 119m

Supported by the;

**ALFON LIGWY** – Plough dredger LOA; 22m

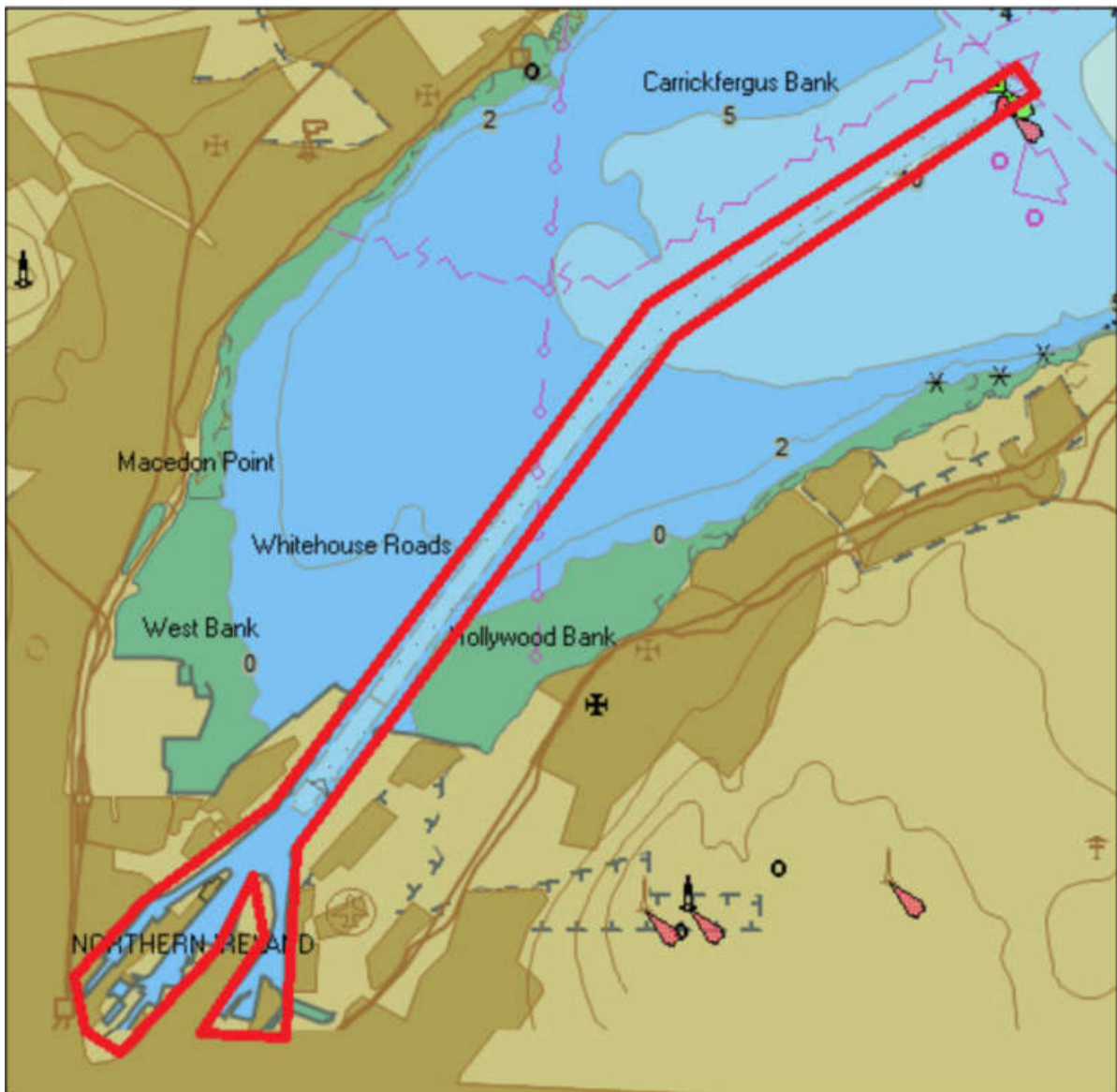
**NORSE** – Hydrographic survey vessel LOA; 21m \**Survey operations commencing 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020 and will continue until the end of the dredging campaign.*

It is possible that a one way traffic system will be put in place as required by the VTS to manage the safe movement of vessels.

All Vessels involved in the Dredging Operation will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch12 and show the required lights and shapes.
