

NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 4b OF 2020

Maritime Declaration of Health for arriving Vessels and in Port Reporting Requirements

Masters of all vessels arriving into Belfast Harbour are advised that they are required to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health at least 24 hours prior to arrival, or where the passage time is less upon departure from the last Port.

In addition to the Maritime Declaration of Health all masters are to complete the attached supplementary questionnaire and submit this along with the Maritime Declaration of Health.

All information should be supplied to your appointed agent for forwarding to the relevant Authorities for assessment.

Masters are also reminded that should a crew member experience a reportable condition during the Vessel's stay they must report this immediately to the Port Authority and Health Authorities.

This Notice supersedes Notice to Mariners No.4a of 2020 Update - Maritime Health Declarations for Arriving Vessels, which is hereby cancelled.
