



NOTICE TO MARINERS

No.10 of 2020 - Works at Belfast Dry Dock

On Friday 3rd July 2020, the Belfast Dry Dock gate will be unstepped and removed for maintenance with operations commencing at 0400.

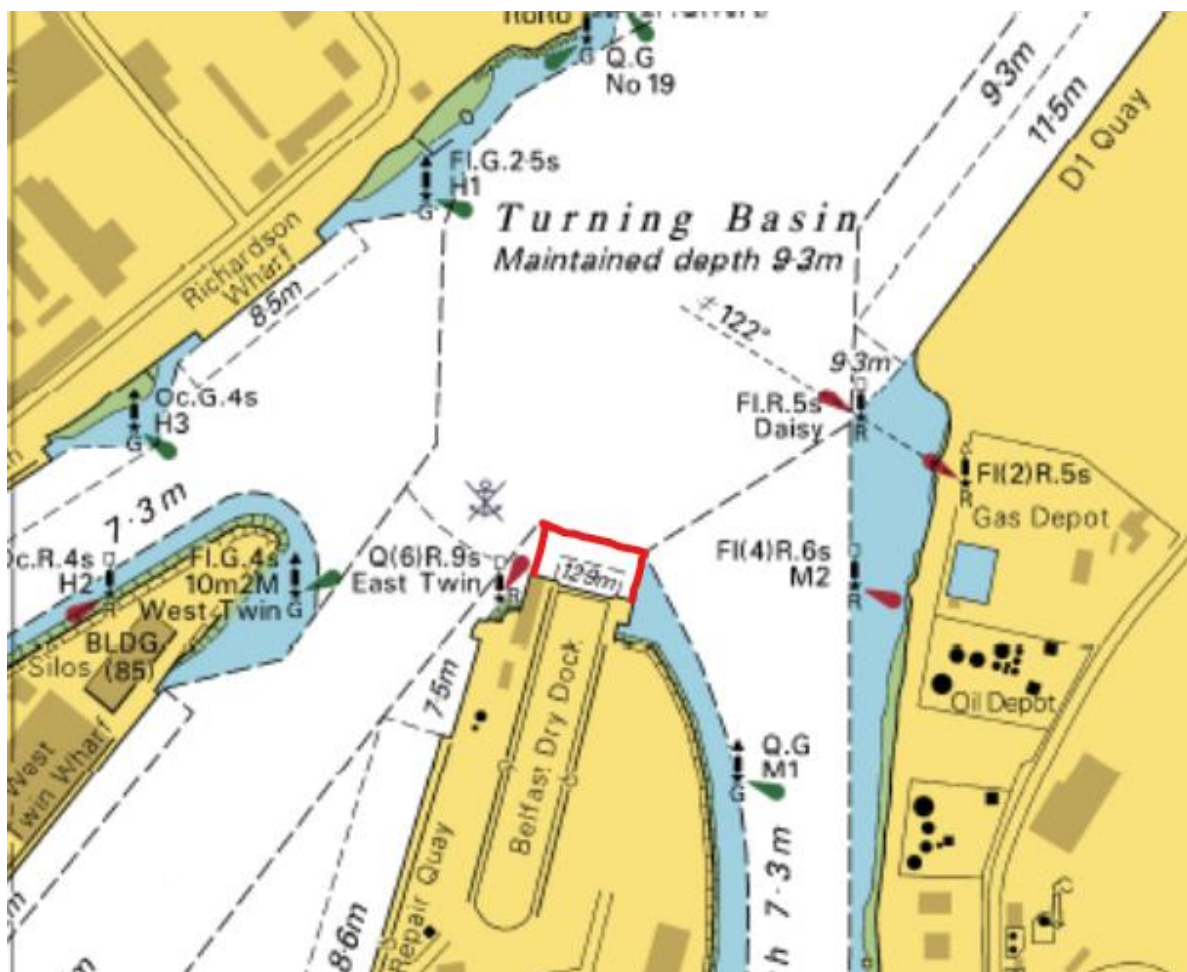
The gate will be moved towards the Turning Circle approximately 15-20 metres and remain there, held on mooring wires, until approx. 1600.

The gate will then be towed through the Musgrave Channel to the Building Dock, by three tugs with additional line-handling vessels also in attendance.

Operations are expected to be complete by 1900.

During this time a strict slow pass with no wash is required from all vessels passing the Turning Circle, keeping well clear of the dry dock entrance and navigating in accordance with the Collision Regulations. VTS will not permit vessels to pass each other in the vicinity of the Turning Circle.

Vessel movements will be actively managed by Belfast VTS and any restriction lifted when safe to do so. Further information is available from Belfast Harbour Radio (VHF Ch 12).
