Marking of Hazard Zones on Edges of General User Quays

All General User berths are now marked with a continuous red line (see photo below) to indicate the Quay Edge Hazard zone



All Quay users are advised that it is Harbour Policy that lifejackets of minimum buoyancy of 150N MUST be worn by all personnel working to the water side of the red lines marked on the quay. Where no line is marked, life-jackets MUST be worn within 2m of the quay edge.

Users are also reminded that additional slip, trip and fall hazards exist in these marked areas including panzer belt surfaces and box-section protectors. Additional care must be taken when working in these areas.
