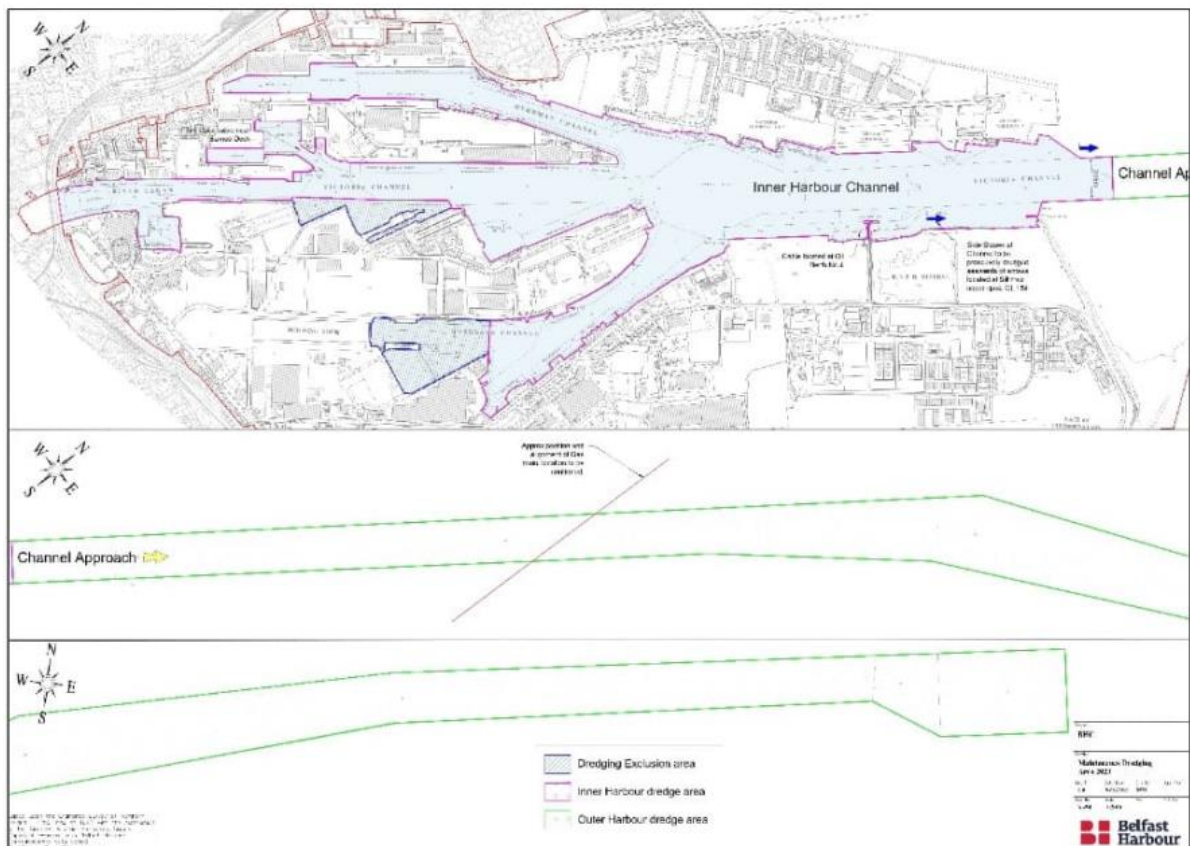

Dredging and hydrographic surveys in Belfast Harbour

Attention all mariners, works are due to commence on maintenance dredging and hydrographic surveys to various channels, Berths, Docks, and Basins in the Port of Belfast (see figure below). This is to include the Main Channel and Turning Circle. Survey works are to commence on 16th August 2023.

Dredging is expected to commence on the 21st of August 2023.

Works are to last for approximately 6 – 8 weeks.



This work will be carried out by the following Vessels:

MAREEL OLIVE – Hydrographic survey vessel LOA; 16m

TRISTAO DE CUNHA - Suction Hopper Dredger LOA; 89m

JENNY D– Plough dredger LOA; 21.6m

It is possible that a one-way traffic system will be put in place as required by the VTS to manage the safe movement of vessels.

All Vessels involved in the Dredging Operation will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch12 and show the required lights and shapes.
