



NOTICE TO MARINERS

No.15 of 2026 – Oil Berth 3 works

Mariners are advised that works to repair fenders, quay and Dolphins at Oil Berth 3 are scheduled to commence on **3rd August 2026**.

Programme is scheduled to take 40 weeks.

The works will include:

- Installation of scaffolding on the jetty and dolphins
- Hot works
- Diving operations
- Lifting operations

All vessels are required to manoeuvre with caution and at reduced speed in the vicinity of Oil Berth 3 and to maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 at all times. A “**No Wake Zone**” will remain in place throughout the works.

The works are being planned to minimise disruption to cargo operations, with as few dolphins and fenders as practicable taken out of service at any one time. However, some unavoidable operational impacts may arise as the works progress.

At certain stages, additional towage may be required to reduce the risk of damage to scaffolding and to fenders undergoing maintenance.

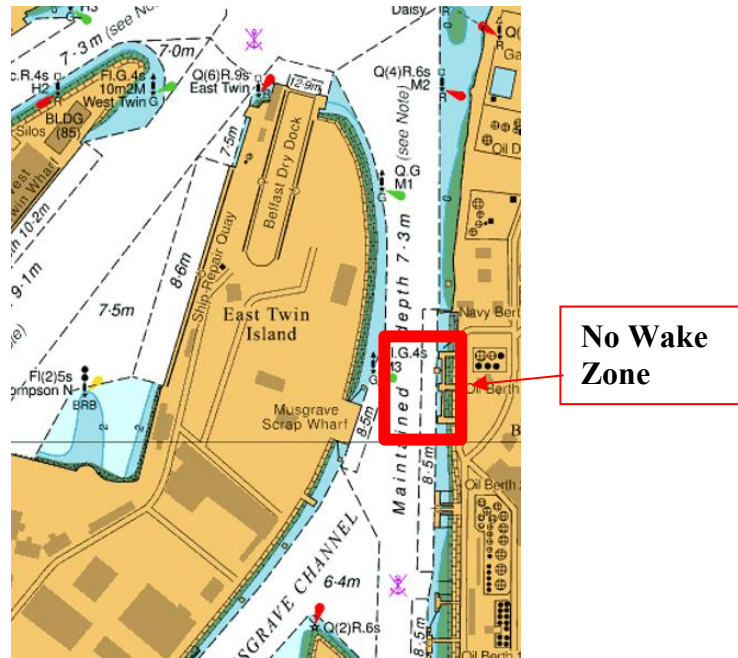


Figure 1: No Wake Zone

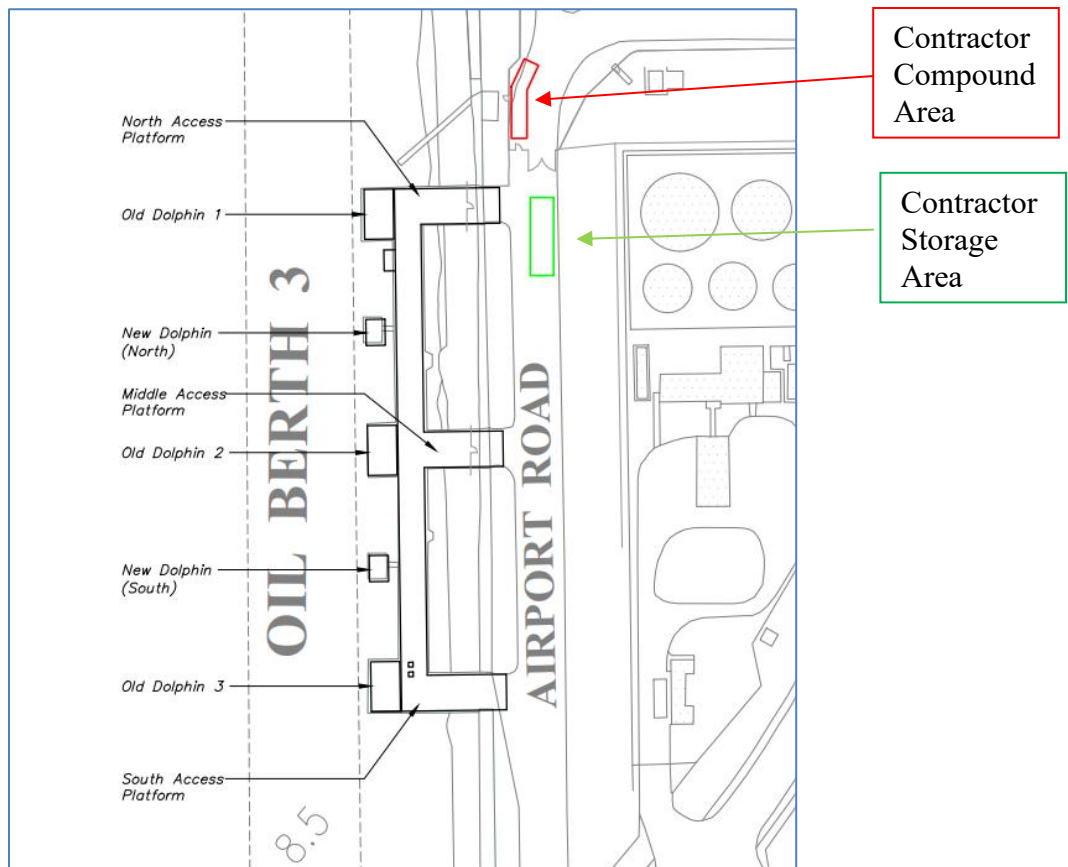


Figure 2: Site Plan
